● Main objectives:

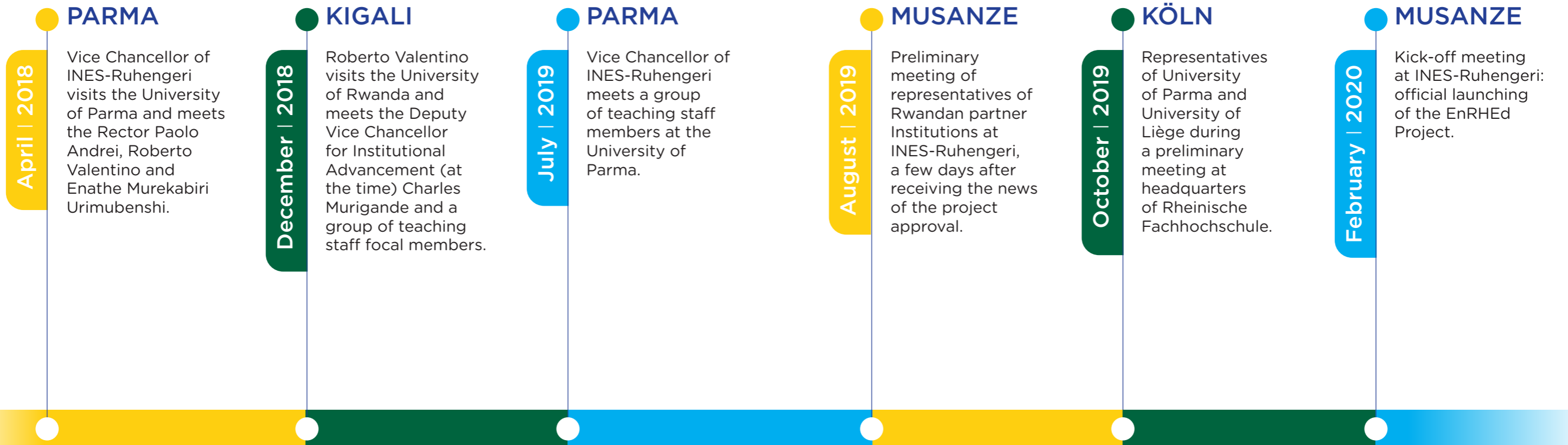
- Revision of current curricula and improvement of the didactic approach through the training of teaching staff members.

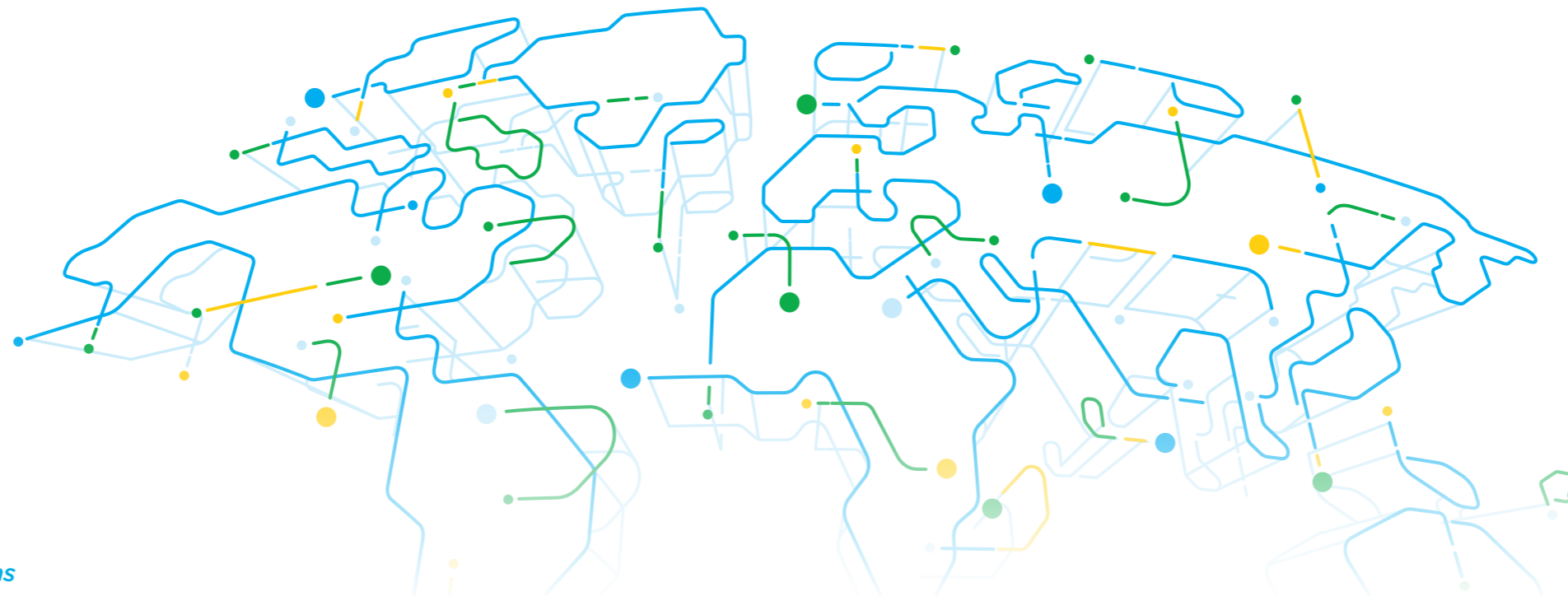

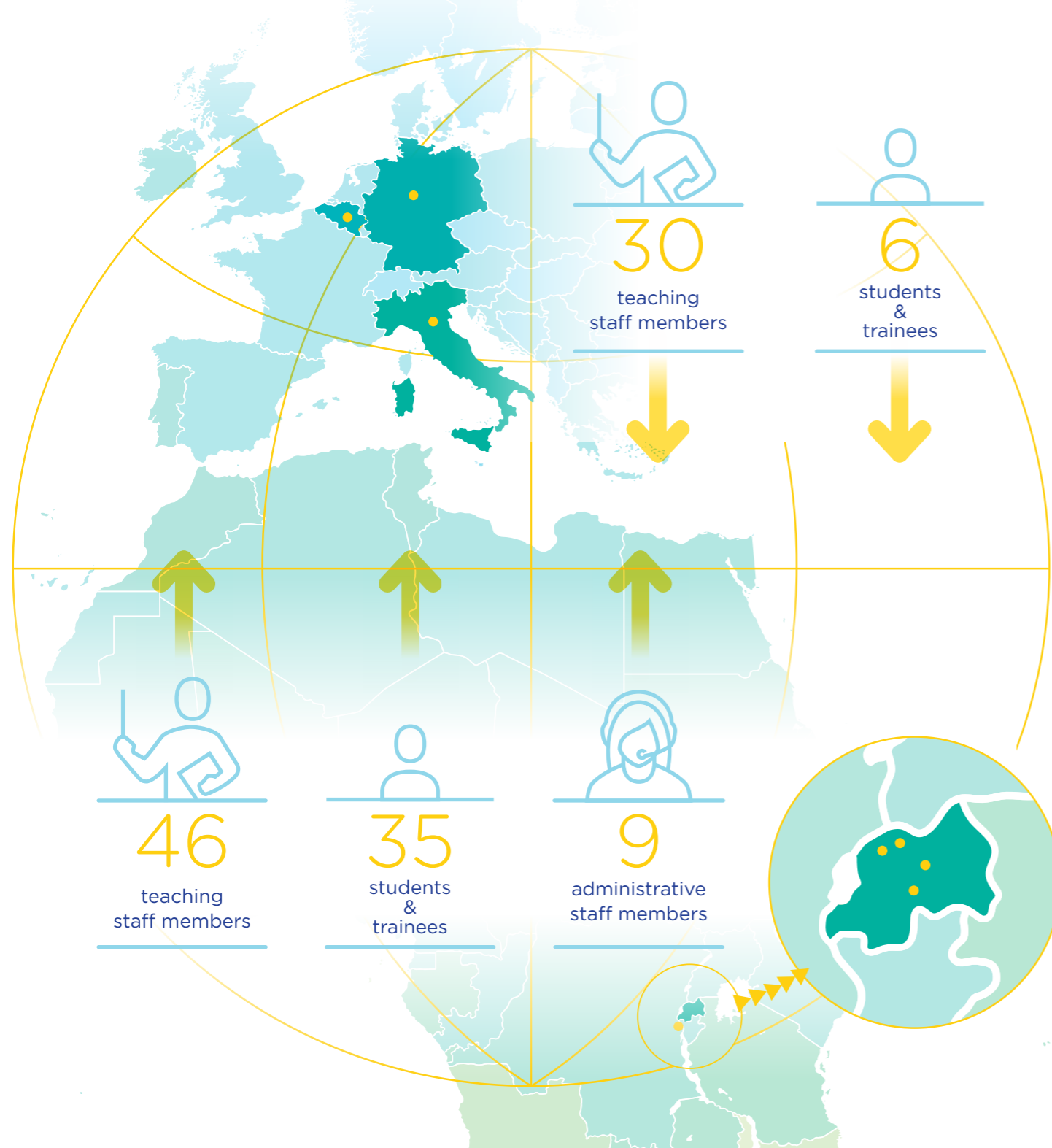

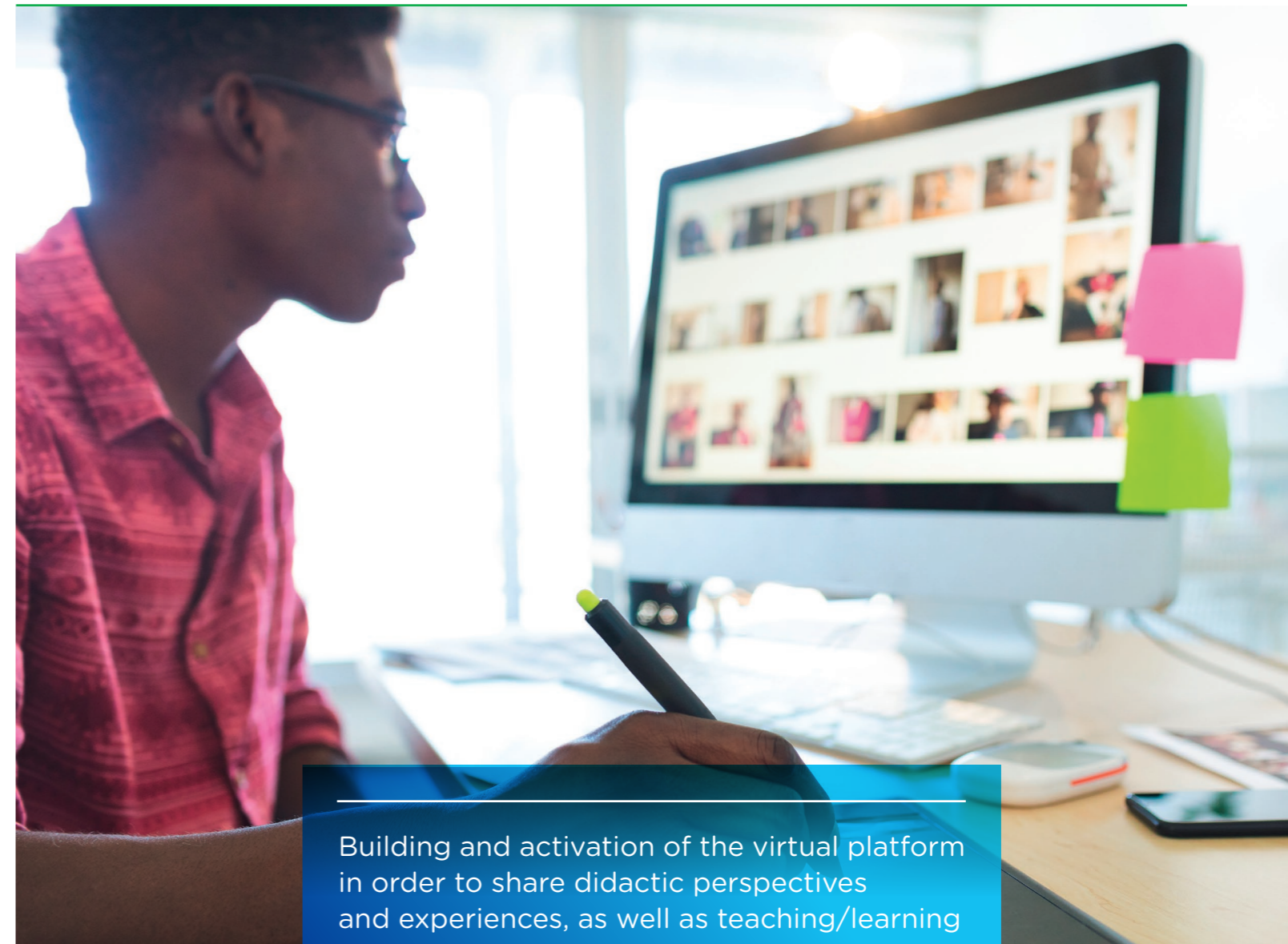
